Ladies and Gentlemen,

We have assembled here today, to express our grief and pay our <u>heartfelt tribute</u>, to eminent Senior Advocate of this Court, Shri Arun Jaitley, who left for his heavenly abode on 24thAugust, 2019.

The personal, educational and professional profile of Late Shri Arun Jaitley has been extensively dealt with by the previous speakers and I do not wish to repeat them again.

The life Shri Jaitley lived, is a remarkable text-book example of how one's faith in himself, <u>devotion</u>, <u>grit</u> and <u>determination</u> in his cause can lead the trajectory of one's life to the zenith of each and every field one touches upon.

Even at a young age, he made his exceptional leadership felt. He was a successful student leader and the faith put in him by the students was well earned. He understood the significance and power of youth in standing up to the authority, and not accepting injustice. He was a remarkable person and a self-made man. As Delhi University Student Union President, he built consensus not only within the university but also brought the elected heads of student unions across the country to support the <u>JP movement</u>, thus turning contribution to the movement <u>into a wave</u>. Even when he was <u>imprisoned for 19 months</u>, he did not panic or lose hope. He utilised this time to become an expert in the Constitution and in the political history of India. He learned through the experience of others and imbibed the true value of empathy.

When it comes to the domain of law, he was a stalwart and a lawyer of exceptional calibre who was respected for his sharp legal acumen and his suave mannerism. He was one of the most loved senior members of the Delhi High Court Bar Association as well as of Supreme Court Bar Association.

Shri Jaitley always supported the various initiatives of the Bar, including the recently launched Delhi High Court Advocates Welfare Trust. He had a very trusting nature, and always <u>made time</u> for those seeking his help. He was one of the <u>most humane</u>, <u>humble and down to earth person</u> who did not hold any grudge against anyone. He was at his articulate best, in the court. The ease with which, he used to dissect, any case threadbare, with his <u>legal acumen</u>, <u>elephantine</u> <u>memory and sharp argumentative skills</u> elevated not just the experience of the court but inspired a new generation of legal minds in this country.

In recognition of his contribution to the practice of law, Shri Jaitley was appointed the Additional Solicitor General of India in 1989 and designated as a Senior Advocate by Delhi High Court in January 1990. He was part of a delegation on behalf of Union of India to the United Nations General Assembly Sessions in June 1998, where the <u>Declaration on Laws Relating to Drugs and Money Laundering</u> was approved. There are so many landmark judgements, which can directly be attributed to his diligence and hardwork.

When it comes to another domain of his life, he came to inhabit, own and redefine politics in this country. He was respected across the entire spectrum. Leaders cutting across party lines, sought his advice, on different matters on numerous occasions. He embodied the spirit of service, to people and to the nation. He was a master consensus builder, in the most trying of the times and a genius trouble-shooter, whenever rays of hope flickered and solutions seemed hard to achieve. He knew the art of persuasion. His charming nature, made it hard, for the opposition, to negate him. The flair with which, he put forward his arguments, in the court and in the Parliament, was uncanny and made everyone in the room take note.

Shri Jaitley was a man with <u>admirable strength</u>, <u>knowledge</u>, <u>wit and humour</u>. He acquired distinction, in all the fields he touched upon, in life as if he had that proverbial Midas touch in his hands. He was a lawyer of great repute and a mentor to many.

Many of us present here, like myself, will recollect, with great fondness, the quiet strength and dignity with which, Shri Jaitley <u>exuberated</u> his brilliance.

Palkhivala has said I quote <u>"It is not true that law defiles, it is not true that law degrades.</u> The legal profession has produced some of the finest and most independent characters whose names are imprinted on the scroll of history". Shri Arun Jaitley was one of those who imprinted his sublime marks on the sands of time.

With the demise of Shri Jaitley, a void has been created and both the Bench and the Bar would be deprived of his professionalism and guidance which was readily available to the lawyers, particularly juniors. Shri Jaitley, during his life, had shown complete professionalism and devotion to duty and the same is a sterling example to the legal fraternity and will act as a guide in future.

The legend never dies. His life and noble deeds continue to inspire.

We have lost a unique talent and a national treasure.

Shri Arun Jaitley left behind several friends and admirers, almost every one of us has a story to tell of his warmth, kindness and generosity.

- A great debator, conversationalist, foodie, and history buff,
- he was a wonderful host and a loyal friend.
- A key strategist and trouble-shooter,
- an eminent lawyer,
- an excellent orator,
- a very good administrator and
- an outstanding parliamentarian.

He was an obedient <u>son</u>, loving <u>husband</u> and caring <u>father</u>.

If the tears could build a stairway and memories a lane, we would walk upto heaven and bring him back home, again.

Shri Jaitley is survived by his wife Mrs. Sangeeta Jaitley, daughter Ms. Sonali Jaitley and son Mr. Rohan Jaitley, both are practicing Advocates.

I, on behalf of my brother and sister Judges, and on my own behalf convey our heartfelt condolences to the members of the bereaved family and pray to God to give them strength to bear this irrecoverable loss. May Almighty bestow peace to the departed soul.
